第一节

A

【语篇导读】本文是一篇应用文。文章是英国航空公司给乘客的通知。

21. C 细节理解题。根据文章第一句“BA0059 to Cape Town”可知此航班目的地为“Cape Town”。从正文的第二段也可知。故选 C。

22. C 推理判断题。根据正文中第五段第一句“Transport back to Heathrow Terminal 4 has been arranged at 14: 15 on 28th September.”可知 C 选项正确，故选 C。
23. D 推理判断题。根据正文中第三段可知航空公司为乘客提供了早餐，午餐，酒店住宿，还有三分钟的免费电话，但不提供回家的交通，故选 D。

B

【语篇导读】本文是一篇记叙文。文章介绍了多伦多街头举办的读书活动。

24. C 细节理解题。根据第二段最后一句可直接获取答案。故选 C。
25. D 判断推理题。通读全文并未提到此次活动后阅读可以取代交通工具。故选 D。
26. A 推理判断题。根据第二段最后一句及第五段倒数第二句获取答案。故选 A。
27. B 文章出处题。本文是篇社会题材的新闻报道，应在报纸的社会版读到。故选 B。

C

【语篇导读】本文是一篇说明文。文章讲述了现如今许多年轻的父母爱在各种社交媒体上“晒娃”，让孩子们感到焦虑和不安的社会现象。

28. B 词义猜测题。根据画线部分“It’s a shock to know that details about their lives have been shared online without their consent or knowledge. (令人震惊的是在这些孩子不知情以及没得到他们许可的情况下，他们日常生活的细节就被分享在网上了。)”可知画线部分表示允许，许可，故选 B。
29. D 细节理解题。根据第四段第一句和第二句“**But it’s not just mommy bloggers who share their children’s information on social media. Plenty of average parents do the same.**”可知 A 不正确；根据第四段第三句“**There’s even a term for it: sharenting.**”可知“sharenting”是由于这个现象的出现才孕育而出的一个新词汇，B 不正确；根据“**according to a study conducted by the internet-security firm AVG.**”可知这家公司是家有关网络安全的公司，C 不正确。根据“**Almost a quarter of children begin their digital lives when parents upload their prenatal sonogram scans (产前超声波扫描) to the internet,**”可知一些孩子在出生前父母就把他们的 B 超影像晒到网上了，故选 D。
30. B 观点态度题。作者通过引用几个孩子和家长的原话来表达自己的态度，根据“**‘It’s weird seeing myself up there, and sometimes there are pictures I don’t like of myself,’**”“**It’s a shock to know that details about their lives have been shared online without their consent or knowledge. And this has become a common experience for many young teens.**”以及文章第三段和最后两段都能体现出作者对家长和学校的这些做法是持反对意见的。故选 B。

31. A 主旨大意题。本文主要讲了许多孩子的个人信息以及他们的成长经历在他们自己都不知情的情况下被父母或学校放到了网上，这一现象甚至在他们出生前就发生了。其它选项都是以偏概全，故选 A。

D

【语篇导读】本文是一篇说明文。文章介绍了严格素食主义者和素食主义者的区别、发展趋势，以及对健康的益处和不足，并强调了科学的补剂和饮食以及健康饮食及生活方式的重要性。

32. A 细节理解题。根据第一段的第二句话可知，故选 A。
33. D 推理判断题。根据第二段可知严格素食主义者在美国发展的趋势是逐年上升的，故选 D。
34. B 考查细节理解。根据第四段第三句话和第四句话，可以知道维生素 B-12 可以在豆浆和燕麦当中获取，故选 B。
35. A 推理判断题。根据整篇文章，作者首先叙述了客观事实，用数据来表明了客观存在的情况，然后文章结束的时候，从客观的角度阐明了健康饮食及生活方式的重要性，所以可以推断出作者的态度是比较客观的。故选 A。

第二节

【语篇导读】本文为新闻报道。介绍了在位于墨尔本的维多利亚国家美术馆举办的中国文物和艺术展。

36. A 根据文章第一句话讲在墨尔本美术馆举办展览可以知道，下面要具体讲的是哪方面的展览。故选 A。
37. D 根据空前句讲的是这个历史学家从堪培拉来墨尔本看这个展览，空后这句提到的是过去的时间，当兵马俑来到维多利亚国家美术馆展览的时候，他们对中国有了不同的看法，所以从 37 题可知是过去的一个时间，他来那个地方也看过这个展览。故选 D。
38. F 根据 38 题前句讲的是这个负责人希望这个展览可以在中国和澳大利亚文化交流之间起非常重要的作用，然后从 38 题后面这句话可以知道它的作用是体现在中国和澳大利亚人民之间建立起相互的信任和友谊，所以要选和前后意思比较贴近的，是这些展览品可以帮助澳大利亚，尤其是澳大利亚的年轻人来进一步的了解中国的文化和当今的中国。故选 F。
39. G 根据后边这个代词 he 可知指的是某一个人，所以反推 39 前面应该是具体有讲到一个人。故选 G。
40. C 根据空前句讲的是这个组织者希望用这些展览可以吸引更多的观众，后句讲的是在这个博物馆的礼品店里他们出售了各种各样周边的产品，尤其是可以吸引儿童的一些产品，可以推断出 40 题应该是他们希望吸引更多年轻一代的关注。故选 C。

第三部分 语言知识运用

第一节

【语篇导读】本文是一篇记叙文。文章叙述了作者在万圣节和朋友在鬼屋被单向乐队惊吓并惊喜到的故事。

41. B 考查动词辨析。根据文章第一句提到了万圣节,可知作者把自己打扮成一个僵尸新娘, *be dressed as* 意思是装扮成……, 故选 B。
42. D 考查连词辨析。此句意思为“我们一边欢呼, 一边就冲进了大雾弥漫的街道”, *as* 作连词, 表示“一边……一边……”, 故选 D。
43. A 考查名词辨析。根据下文可知作者和她的朋友进入到一座闹鬼的屋子, 此句意为“当我们转过拐角, 一下就看到一座闹鬼的屋子”, 故选 A。
44. C 考查副词辨析。“Oh, we are so going in!”意思是“我们太想进去了!”, 故选 C。
45. C 考查副词辨析。“We all jumped back, then nervously slipped inside.”意思为“我们全都往后退, 然后紧张的溜了进去”, 由于害怕, 此时作者是很紧张的, 故选 C。
46. B 考查动词辨析。句意: 突然, 一个僵尸跳了出来, 我们尖叫起来。“scream”是尖叫的意思, 故选 B。
47. B 考查不定代词辨析。我们全都跑到隔壁的房间。根据文章第一段第一句可知作者邀请了她的朋友过万圣节, 不止请了一个朋友, *both* 只能是两人, *all* 指代三人以上, 故选 B。
48. A 考查形容词辨析。从下半句“you couldn't see anything.”和第一段的“We cheered as we stormed off into the foggy streets.”可知当时大雾弥漫, 什么也看不清, 故选 A。
49. A 考查动词辨析。根据 *howl* (嚎叫, 大声叫喊) 这个词可判断是听到 (heard), 故选 A。
50. C 考查名词辨析。从下一句“‘Who's the lucky person that gets the honor of being my next meal?’ he shouted.”可知跳出来的是一个满身是毛的男子。故选 C。
51. C 考查动词词组辨析。*waste one's breath* 白费口舌; *save one's breath* 省口气吧; *catch one's breath* 喘口气; *hold one's breath* 屏住呼吸。句意: 我们还没来得及喘口气, 一个怪物就从湖里朝我们扑来, 故选 C。
52. B 考查动词词组辨析。*feel one's way* 摸索着前进; *make one's way*, 朝着……前进; *find one's way* 找到出路; *build one's way* 建立某人的方式。句意: 怪物朝我们扑来, 故选 B。
53. B 考查习惯用语辨析。“No deal.”意思是不成交, 不行。文中湖里的怪物对作者喊叫, 叫他们去, 但他们坚决不答应, 故选 B。
54. D 考查连词辨析。“be about to do sth... when...”意思是“正要做……, 这时……”, 此句意思是我们正要跑出去, 这时其中的一个人说“等等, 我已经不想吓你们了, 我想让你们看看我是谁”, 故选 D。
55. A 考查动词辨析。这人抓起一块毛巾, 把脸上化的恐怖的妆擦掉, “wipe...off”是擦掉的意思, 故选 A。
56. D 考查动词辨析。当作者看到是单向乐队的人时, 简直不敢相信, 故选 D。

57. C 考查形容词辨析。句意：你们刚被单向乐队的成员吓过。scared 是害怕，被吓到，故选 C。
58. D 考查人称代词辨析。句意：单向乐队中的一人对着其他成员说“你们现身吧。” reveal 是揭开，揭露的意思，故选 D。
59. B 考查动词辨析。句意：接下来，整个乐队的成员都站在了我的面前。故选 B。
60. A 考查动词辨析。作者不相信是真的，但 Harry 回答了作者的话，所以用“replied”，故选 A。

第二节

61. particularly 考查副词。particularly 修饰形容词“pleasant”，故填 particularly。
62. to 考查介词。arrest attention to 为固定搭配“吸引……的注意力”，故填 to。
63. gave 考查时态。此句意思为：这位 50 岁的新加坡人六年前放弃了他在建筑业的工作，创建了世界卫生间组织。全文时态为一般过去时，故填 gave。
64. a 考查不定冠词。此句意思为：也许听起来像一个笑话。“joke”是可数名词单数，故填 a。
65. affordable 考查形容词。此句意为：他的世界卫生间组织的目标是让每一个人都能拥有干净、安全、负担得起的卫生间。形容词修饰名称“sanitation”，故填 affordable。
66. because 考查连词。此句意为：厕所得不到改善是因为人们不愿意谈论它。强调因果关系，故填 because。
67. that 考查名词性从句中表语从句的关系代词。故填 that。
68. be respected 考查被动语态。此句意为：他们的父母教导他们说，如果你们的后半辈子想被人尊重的话那么千万不要提及跟厕所有关的话题。应用被动，故填 be respected。
69. tasks 考查名词复数。one of 后面要跟名词复数，故填 tasks。
70. marketing 考查非谓语动词。此句意为：这是一种向他们营销（厕所）的非常重要的途径。动名词作介词 of 的宾语，故填 marketing。
