### 书面表达评分原则

1. 本题总分为 25 分, 按 5 个档次给分。

3. 词数少于 80 和多于 120 的, 从总分中减去 2 分。
4. 评分时应注意的主要内容为: 内容要点、应用词汇和语法结构的数量和准确性及上下文的连贯性。
5. 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个方面。评分时应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。英、美拼写及词汇用法均可接受。
